SUMMARY :

CONSTRUCTION BEGINS : THE INNER LOOP

The Inner Loop, Spur 601 is 85% designed and construction has started on Segment A (Loop 375 to Airport Road).

Two new intersections at Global Reach and Constitution Avenue are currently under construction. These intersections will provide two new access control point gates into Fort Bliss.

The Global Reach intersection will meet the August 31st deadline as designated by Fort Bliss.

Utility relocation and right of way acquisition are proceeding on schedule on both Segment A and Segment B (from Airport Rd to US 54).

Utility work is ongoing in Segment B adjacent to Fred Wilson Road as well as drainage work in Segment A.

Structure foundation has been placed within the Abrams US 54 contract to accommodate the direct connect structures of

the Spur 601 and US 54 interchange.

The project currently employs approximately 190 people executing construction, design, quality control and project management..
